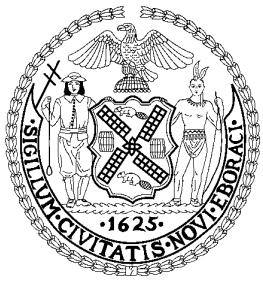

**The Ron Brown Scholar Program** This program seeks to identify African-American high school seniors who will make significant contributions to society. Applicants must excel academically, exhibit exceptional leadership potential, participate in community service activities and demonstrate financial need. The applicant must be a US citizen or hold a permanent resident visa card. Current college students are not eligible to apply. Recipients may use the renewable scholarships to attend an accredited four-year college or university of their choice within the United States. Ron Brown Scholarships are not limited to any specific field or career objective and may be used to pursue any academic discipline. ### **The Hood Sportsmanship Scholarship**

The Hood Sportsmanship Scholarship Program rewards high school student athletes with \$5,000 toward furthering their education at a 2 or 4 year accredited college or university. To be eligible, high school seniors must have proven their ability to put the spirit of competition above winning while participating in a varsity sport. These students must have also earned a cumulative 3.0 GPA or higher and performed volunteer work in the community. Applicants will be asked to write an essay explaining how they display sportsmanship and integrity on and off the field. **Deadline: February 1**

### **Military Commanders' Scholarship Fund**

Applicants to the Military Commanders' Scholarship Fund must: be dependent children of active duty, reserve, National Guard or retired members of the United States military who hold valid Exchange & Commissary shopping privileges at the time of application, be high school seniors or graduates who plan to enroll for the first time in a full time undergraduate course of study at an accredited two-year or four-year college or university, and have a minimum cumulative 3.5 grade point average on a 4.0 scale, or the equivalent, at the time of application. **Applications must be postmarked no later than February 15. Only the first 100 applications received will be acknowledged and processed.**
