The AP Exam is a required component of the AP course; all AP students are required to sit for the Advanced Placement Exam. The AP Exams are required for Advanced Placement designation on your high school transcript, and will be used to determine possible future college credit.

1. **Cost:** The cost for this exam is **\$79.00**. Fee waivers are available for students on the basis of eligibility for free, or reduced price lunch. Please contact Ms. Harris/Ms. Wise.
2. **Due:** Payment for AP exams is due no later than **Friday, April 8, 2011**.
3. **Submitting Payment:** {A} Payments for all AP Exams (grades 11 and 12) except World History should be submitted to **Ms. Harris**.

{B} Payments for **AP World History** (grade 10) should be submitted to **Ms. Wise**.

- Students who are taking multiple exams should submit ONE check for payment.
